Parkhurst State School will receive

\$150,578*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Year Three learners achieving at and above the National Minimum Standard in Reading, from 95.3% in 2018 to 98% by 2020.
- Increase the percentage of ALL learners achieving a 'C' standard and above in English and Mathematics on end of Semester Report Cards to 85%.
- Increase the Upper Three Band (U3B) representation of Year Three and Year Five learners to 60% and above in Reading and Writing through targeted and differentiated interventions, including 'Boost Groups, Programs and Workshops.
- Deliver differentiated Learning Plans for every learner at risk of not achieving a 'C' standard at their level and for those already attaining an 'A' standard in English and Mathematics.

Our initiatives include


- Releasing four Curriculum Leaders (Neighbourhood Mayors) fortnightly to oversee curriculum development, calibrate assessment and develop teachers as high performing and expert teaching teams.
- Further build staff capacity and leadership to deliver quality, high yield pedagogies to embed consistent practices across the school.
- Provide additional casual Teacher Aide support to ensure every Prep/Year 1 learner has the opportunity to be read to and read to an adult every day.
- Provide onsite coaching, modelling, professional support and feedback to all staff to embed quality reading pedagogies with impact, informed by regular data collections and analysis.
- Further supplement school wide curriculum resources.
- Provide Teacher Release time for curriculum planning and classroom observations through collegial engagement.
- Further build an enjoyment of reading by resourcing the school's Practice Achieve Weekly Success (PAWS) Reading Incentives Program
