Staffing Update

Dan Evans and Rachel Sampson will continue to serve in their current acting roles into Term 4, with a potential to extend their roles until the end of 2023 school year. It is hoped that the current situation will be resolved for the start of the 2024 school year.

School Supervisor Visit

There has been a state-wide system shift. The new structure has led to the evolution of the Assistant Regional Director (ARD) role into that of School Supervisors. Alongside the transition, a Principal Advisors Services (PAES) have also been assigned to our school, collectively aimed at providing tailored supervision and support. The extent of support will be determined by our school's datasets, a copy of which is attached for your perusal.

Leisa Neaton has been assigned as our School Supervisor. During her visit in the second week of this term, we engaged in discussions surrounding our P-2 English data and the strategies the school has undertaken to enhance student achievements. The focal point of our conversation revolved around the continual development of teacher capability. Going forward, all support and discussions will be anchored in data analysis, a renewed focus that aligns with our ongoing priorities.

Parent Teacher Interviews

As we approach the end of this school term, Parents teacher interviews will be scheduled for week 10. Each classroom teacher will communicate their availability. This will be the same process as previous. We strongly encourage all parents and caregivers to seize this opportunity to engage in productive discussions about their child's progress.

Facilities and Infrastructure

The carpark at the norther end of the school has been successfully completed and is now in use. This designated parking area is exclusively for staff member and requires an access pin for entry.

Regarding the kiss and go area, discussion is underway to potentially open the second lane. However, this step will not be taken until a secure fence has ben installed to effectively separate students from incoming traffic. Our commitment to student safety remains our priority.

The school gates will remain closed until 2:50pm as a further precautionary measure to ensure the safety of our students.
