Staffing Update

We are pleased to announce that Mrs Rhiannon McPherson has returned to Parkhurst State School this term. She will be taking over as the new teacher for 2/3M while Silvie Moravek is on leave for the remainder of 2023. In other staffing news the department is extending the contracts of both Mr Daniel Evans and Ms Rachel Sampson until Week 4 of Term 3.

Semester One Reporting

At the end of each semester, a written report is provided to each student. Reports are completed using the approved One School template. Judgements are presented in line with the P-12 Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Framework. As a school we aim to keep our reporting processes **clear and transparent** for parents and the community, so that parents understand:

- the learning expectations for the student
- the student's achievement against expected standards
- how well the student is engaging with the expected learning
- how the learner may be able to improve

Facilities and Infrastructure

The latest schedule has the completion date set for June 6th, 2023. The tuckshop is now functional and awaiting final inspections, while the administration building has been carpeted and is ready for the installation of fixtures and finishes. We expect the furniture to arrive in about two weeks. As Paynters prepares to remove their site offices, we're excited to welcome landscaping contractors to site. Paynters will be conducting a thorough hand-over with the school, including defect checks.

In addition to these updates, we're pleased to announce that construction of the staff carpark has begun. This carpark will provide space for 16 cars and will be accessible via an electric security gate. We anticipate that the carpark will be completed by mid-July 2023, providing a convenient and secure parking solution for our staff.

2024 School Planning

Our 2024 workforce planning will begin this week, and we'll be submitting the Notice of Intentions for 2024 Advice to our staff. This form will allow our leadership team identify which staff members will be staying, transferring, or taking leave, so that we can work with our Regional HR to fill any vacant positions. We're committed to creating a strong and capable team for the next year ahead, and we're looking forward to working with our staff to make it happen.

ARD Visit

Peter Tanzer, Assistant Regional Director for Parkhurst State School, will be visiting on Thursday, May 12th. During his visit, we'll be focussing on traction of evidence relating to our school improvement agenda. Our top priority is to ensure that the work we've invested in is making the biggest and best difference to student learning. We'll be reviewing our targets and initiatives to determine if we're on track or if any adjustments need to be made.

As we move into Term 2, this will be the final term for the ARD role in schools. The department is moving to a new model of supervision and capability development for principals. The recruitment and selection processes for these new positions are currently underway, and we're looking forward to seeing how these changes will positively impact our school in the future.
